

Scholarship Information

The National Propane Gas Foundation Scholarship Fund was established in 1994 by a committed group of energized volunteers. Its purpose is to foster educational opportunities for the children of National Propane Gas Association (NPGA) member companies by offering scholarships to colleges or vocational/technical schools. The fund provides non-renewable scholarships in the amounts of \$1,000 - \$2,000. Scholarships are funded from Scholarship Fund endowments earmarked for that purpose and managed by the NPG Foundation. The only limit on the number of scholarships granted is the size of the endowment and the rate of interest that it generates.

Applications for the Beth Johnson Memorial Scholarship and the Bill and Florene Wray Memorial Scholarship can be completed online using the same application process when applying for a National Propane Gas Foundation Scholarship. The Beth Johnson Memorial Scholarship provides scholarships to dependents of propane industry employees in Kansas. Beth Johnson was the wife of Ken Johnson, long time PMAK executive director. The Bill and Florene Wray Memorial Scholarship is an annual \$1,000 scholarship which was awarded beginning in the 2012-2013 academic year. This scholarship is awarded to a qualified applicant who is a dependent of an NPGA and state association member from Kansas or Nebraska. Bill and Florene Wray were owners of Fairbank Equipment. Applications must be completed and all required information and documents must be received by stated deadlines found on application form. Successful applicants will be notified by NPGF. NPGF will only accept online applications for scholarships. Written high school and college transcripts will still be accepted.
